- 2) Applicants/riders must be experienced and in complete control of horse at all times.
- 3) Applicants/riders must carry a flag and have their own flag boot.
- 4) Applicants must have their own transportation.
- 5) Applicants must be 14 years of age by the tryout date. Applicants 16 years and younger must furnish proof of age.
- 6) Once chosen for the team, all practices, performance, and the parade are mandatory.
- 7) Once chosen for the team, a \$100 cash deposit is required.
- 8) Horse requirement*:
 - A) No stud horses NO EXCEPTIONS
 - B) No large breed horses (i.e.: Clydesdale, draft, warm blood)
 - C) No gaited horses
 - D) No ponies
 - E) No mules or donkeys
- 9) Additional rules and regulations will be available during pre-tryout meeting.
- 10) The Reno Rodeo Association reserves the right to amend these requirements at any time, for any reason without notice.
- 1. *Senior riders excluded, unless a new horse is being used or horse problems existed the previous year.
- 2. *Senior riders with already qualified horses are exempt.

(Senior riders are those that have ridden 5 consecutive years, starting their sixth year.)

All senior riders must participate in tryouts.
